Dear Parents & Carers,

Funding Changes for Your Catholic School

You are invited to attend one of the five parent forums I am holding to discuss some of the serious concerns I have about the long-term funding of our schools and to explain the problems and risks of the Government's proposed funding model and how this could impact your local Catholic school. Teachers and school staff are also most welcome to attend.

It is no secret that the Broken Bay Catholic school community is deeply concerned that our Catholic students could be seriously disadvantaged by the Federal Government's proposed school funding model changes outlined in the 2017/18 Federal Budget. In particular, our ability to work <u>as a system</u> of Catholic schools that supports and assists each other is at risk.

As a system of schools, we take very seriously the financial stewardship of the resources we are provided to fund the diverse needs of our students irrespective of their family background, where they live or their financial circumstances.

The funding distribution model we currently use allows funds to be allocated across all our 44 Catholic schools. It also provides for a reasonably consistent low fee cost structure and opportunities for every school community. The new proposed government model would lead to greater disparity of fees from one school to another.

Current debate around school funding has been both intense and confusing for many. That is why it is important that we are fully informed around the complex issues at hand. The Parent Forums on offer are an excellent opportunity to hear directly from our Director of Schools in Broken Bay. I fully support the work of Peter Hamill and the Catholic Schools Office, and strongly encourage all parents and carers to attend a Forum in their local area.
