Key Themes: "I will make a virtuous branch grow from David". Lord, teach me Your paths. May the Lord make you love the whole human race. The Son of Man is coming: Stay awake for that day.				
Notes: (1) (2)	Advent is a season of preparation, reflection and waiting. Try and reflect this in your music. A change of the Mass setting is desirable - see below. Memorial acclamations 1 & 2 emphasise " until you come again" and are more appropriate for this season. Leading up to Christmas, try and avoid pieces such as the Celtic Alleluia, whose energy better suits Christmas. If we have all our grand music during Advent, there is no contrast with what has gone before and what comes after.			
(3) Remember that the Gloria is not said in Advent play the Kyrie if appropriate. Please try to use the Advent Alleluia - we have done this before - and the Advent hymns listed below
