Key Themes: Repent and be baptized. The Lord is my shepherd. We are called to bear our suffering as Christ suffered for us. "I have come that they may have life".

Notes:	(1)	Avoid the temptation to overload the mass with "Shepherd" references. Use perhaps
		one in addition to the Psalm. Other hymns reflecting god's love and protection, or
		referring to some of the other readings, will balance the mass better.

(2) The hymn "The Lord's My Shepherd" is through composed and should not be used as substitute for the responsorial psalm, although it can be sung elsewhere.
