Fourth Sunday Of Easter, Year B

Key Themes: The stone rejected by the builders has become the cornerstone. It is only through Christ that we are saved. We are God's children. The Good Shepherd lays down

his life for his sheep.

Notes: Avoid the temptation to overload the mass with "Shepherd" references. Use perhaps one in

addition to the Psalm. Other hymns reflecting god's love and protection, or referring to some of

the other readings, will balance the mass better.
