First Sunday of Lent, Year A

Key Themes: God fashioned man of dust. Sin enters the world. Have mercy on me, O Lord. Create a pure heart for me. Divine grace comes through the obedience of Jesus Christ. Jesus fasted for forty days and was tempted in the desert.

Notes: (1) During Lent, we do not say (or sing) the Gloria. Also, the Gospel acclamation does not use the word "Alleluia", nor should other hymns or acclamations.

Tree Of Life" (GAUS 307) is a useful hymn to play throughout Lent. Play the general Lenten Verse, then the verse appropriate for the relevant Sunday, then go to the normal verse 1 and following.
