

Second Sunday of Lent, Year A

Key Themes: Abraham is called to be the father of God's people. The works of the Lord are to be trusted. He will rescue us from death. God has saved us and calls us to be holy. Jesus is transfigured: His face shone like the sun.

- Notes:** (1) During Lent, we do not say (or sing) the Gloria. Also, the Gospel acclamation does not use the word "Alleluia", nor should other hymns or acclamations.
- (2) "Tree Of Life" (GAUS 307) is a useful hymn to play throughout Lent. Play the general Lenten Verse, then the verse appropriate for the relevant Sunday, then go to the normal verse 1 and following.
