## First Sunday of Lent, Year C

Key Themes: We called on the Lord and He brought us from a land of toil and oppression. Be with me, Lord, when I am in trouble. The Lord is our refuge. Believe that Jesus is Lord and God raised Him from the dead. There is no distinction between Jew and Greek. Jesus was lead by the Spirit through the desert where He was tempted.

Notes: (1) During Lent, we do not say (or sing) the Gloria. Also, the Gospel acclamation does not use the word "Alleluia", nor should other hymns or acclamations.
