

Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year A

Key Themes: All who cling to my covenant, these will I lead to my holy mountain. Let the nations exult, for you rule the world with justice. God never takes back His gifts or revokes His choice. The faith of the Canaanite woman brings God's healing to her daughter.

Mass: Mass of St. Francis/Mass of Creation (NEW version)/Mass of the Blessed Trinity

Psalm: Let All The Peoples Praise You (Colin Smith)
O God, O God, Let All The Nations Praise You (Carroll/Gelineau - CWB)

Note* Let All The Peoples (GAUS 60) references the Psalm, but the words vary significantly. Use it as a hymn, but do not use it for the Psalm.

Suggested Alleluia: For Ordinary time, avoid using the Celtic Alleluia - keep it for Christmas, Easter and other feasts. If your mass setting has a setting, use it.
