Key Themes: I am a great king, says the Lord of hosts. You have strayed from the way, profaning the covenant. In You, O Lord, I have found my peace. Beware of those who do not practice what they preach.

Mass: Mass of St. Francis/Mass of Creation (NEW version)/Mass of the Blessed Trinity

Psalm: In You, O Lord, I Have Found My Peace (Colin Smith)

Suggested Alleluia: For Ordinary time, avoid using the Celtic Alleluia - keep it for Christmas, Easter and other feasts. If your mass setting has a setting, use it.
