

# Second Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year B

Key Themes: Speak, O Lord, your servant is listening. Here I am, I come to do your will. Your bodies are members of the body of Christ. Jesus calls Andrew and Simon to be his followers.

Mass: Mass of St. Francis/Mass of Creation (NEW version)/Mass of the Blessed Trinity

Psalm: Here Am I, Lord Colin Smith  
Here Am I, Lord Murray/Boschetti CWB 352  
NOTE: Here I Am Lord (GAUS 496 is NOT a Psalm and should not be sung here.)

Suggested Alleluia: For Ordinary time, avoid using the Celtic Alleluia - keep it for Christmas, Easter and other feasts. If your mass setting has a setting, use it. Halle, Halle, Halle is another possibility. There are others in the service music section of GAUS as well as Alleluia, Alleluia, Give Thanks (GAUS 360) where the refrain can be used as a seasonal response.
