**Key Themes:** To bring help to the outcast, Jesus became an outcast himself. The one who is unclean must live alone. In times of trouble, Lord, I turn to you. Rejoice, for I will confess my guilt to the Lord and be forgiven. Whatever you do, do it for the glory of God. Never do anything offensive to anyone, be anxious for the advantage of everyone else. Jesus cures the leper of his sickness.

**Psalm:** In Time Of Trouble Colin Smith

**Suggested Alleluia:** For Ordinary time, avoid using the Celtic Alleluia - keep it for Christmas, Easter and other feasts. If your mass setting has a setting, use it. Halle, Halle, Halle is another possibility. There are others in the service music section of GAUS as well as Alleluia, Alleluia, Give Thanks (GAUS 360) where the refrain can be used as a seasonal response.
