

Second Sunday Of Easter, Year C

Key Themes: Many came to believe in the Lord. God's love is everlasting. "I was dead and now live forever". Blessed are those who have not seen and yet believe.

NOTE: Easter is not only a single Sunday, but a celebration that extends 50 days to Pentecost. Many of the hymns in the Easter section (GAUS 350 -368) may be equally appropriate. Check the verses, or perhaps consider them as quiet music.
