

Fifth Sunday Of Easter, Year C

Key Themes: We must experience hardships before we enter the kingdom. I will praise your name. The Lord is kind and compassionate. The new Jerusalem. There will be no more death. The son of Man has been glorified. Love one another as I have loved you.

NOTE: Easter is not only a single Sunday, but a celebration that extends 50 days to Pentecost. Many of the hymns in the Easter section (GAUS 350 -368) may be equally appropriate. Check the verses, or perhaps consider them as quiet music.
