

# Sunday Of The Ascension, Year C

Key Themes: Soon you will be baptized by the Spirit. Why are you standing looking up to the sky. God is king over all the earth. Jesus is ruler over all. Go and preach repentance to all the nations.

NOTE: Easter is not only a single Sunday, but a celebration that extends 50 days to Pentecost. Many of the hymns in the Easter section (GAUS 350 -368) may be equally appropriate. Check the verses, or perhaps consider them as quiet music.
