Key Themes: Before the earth came into being, the Wisdom of God was there. You have created heaven and earth, and all within it. The love of God has been poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit. Everything the Father has is mine. When the Spirit comes, all he tells you will be taken from what is mine.

Note: As an alternative to using lots of specific Trinity hymns, separate songs could be sung individually praising Father, Son and Spirit.
