Key Themes: I am the Lord, unrivalled; there is no other God beside me. Tell God's glory to all the peoples. You have been chosen. Give to God the things that belong to God.

Mass: Mass of St. Francis/Mass of Creation (NEW version)/Mass of the Blessed Trinity

Psalm: Give The Lord Glory And Honour (Colin Smith)
Give The Lord Glory And Honour (Rayson - CWB)

Suggested Alleluia: For Ordinary time, avoid using the Celtic Alleluia - keep it for Christmas, Easter and other feasts. If your mass setting has a setting, use it.
