Suggested Alleluia: For Ordinary time, avoid using the Celtic Alleluia - keep it for Christmas, Easter and

other feasts. If your mass setting has a setting, use it. Halle, Halle, Halle is another possibility. There are others in the service music section of GAUS as well as Alleluia,

Alleluia, Give Thanks (GAUS 360) where the refrain can be used as a seasonal

response.
